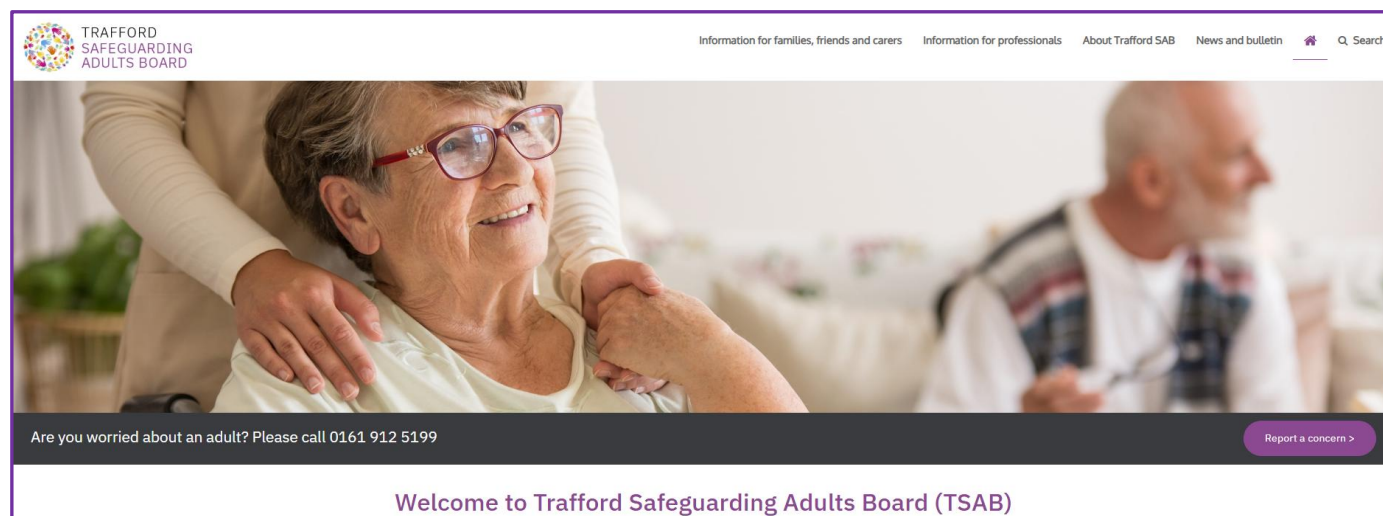

Safeguarding Refugees and Asylum Seekers

The legislation surrounding the UK asylum and immigration system can seem complicated. TSAB has been working with colleagues from Housing and the Safeguarding Hub on a guide to help practitioners feel confident supporting people who may be non-UK nationals.

As well as providing details of useful services offering immigration and asylum support to individuals and families in Trafford, the guide explains terms such as No Recourse to Public Funds, how to check UK immigration status, and information about healthcare and homelessness rights and support.
